

Resume Vyacheslav Aronovich Butkovsky

President of the International Industrial Academy, ICC Academician, Professor, honored worker of the food industry of the Russian Federation. More than 50 years of experience in the sphere of additional professional education, constantly heading the Institute for Advanced Training of leaders and specialists of the bakery product system, transformed in 1992 into the Institute of Processing Industry, and in 2001 – into the International Industrial Academy (IIA).

Over 50 years of leadership of the Institute and the Academy, a modern training and production base has been created, equipped with innovative technical training tools and instruments, on which specialists from most sectors of the agro-industrial complex improve their qualifications.

Being the rector of the International Industrial Academy, Butkovsky V.A. headed the Russian Union of Flour Mills and Cereal Plants for five years as the president of the Union.

Scientific interests of Butkovsky V.A. lie in increasing the efficiency of technological processes for processing grain into flour. Butkovsky V.A. has 8 inventions, is the author of more than 300 publications, including 17 textbooks for universities and technical schools, which trained several generations of specialists in flour and cereal and other grain processing industries. He leads the scientific direction for training researchers in postgraduate scientific specialty "The technology of storing and processing of cereals, legumes and cereal products".

Butkovsky V.A. is a member of the editorial boards of the industry magazines: "Food Industry", "Khleboproducty" ("Grain products"), "Compound Feed" (Russia), and "Grain Storage and Processing" (Ukraine).

Labor merits of Butkovsky V.A. awarded with high state rewards: Orders "For merit to the Fatherland" III and IV degrees, Order of the Red Banner of Labor, Order of the October Revolution, "Badge of Honor" and many medals. Butkovsky V.A. was awarded the gold medal of the Ministry of Agriculture of the Russian Federation "For Contribution to the Development of the Russian Agro-Industrial Complex".

Taking an active part in the work of the ICC, IIA President Butkovsky V.A. leads the education working group at ICC.

Scientific and educational activities of Professor **Butkovsky V.A.** highly appreciated by the world community and was awarded with the presentation of the highest award of the International Association for Cereal Science and Technology at the ICC International Congress in Sydney, Australia in 2000 – **the grand silver medal of Friedrich Schweitzer** "For outstanding services in promoting the goals and ideals of the International Society for the Science and Technology of Grain ICC".
